We have reviewed respondent's opposition to the petition for writ of mandamus. The opposition provided this court with the Immigration Judge's ("IJ") January 11, 2018 order granting petitioner's motion to reopen immigration proceedings and the declaration of Tami Nelson stating that respondent has begun the process of facilitating petitioner's return to the United States.

The petition for a writ of mandamus is granted.

Respondent is ordered to return petitioner to the United States through the Port of Entry at San Ysidro, California, no later than January 16, 2018.

Upon petitioner's entry to the United States, respondent is further ordered to transport petitioner from San Ysidro, California, to Kansas City, Missouri.

Respondent is further ordered to provide petitioner with his necessary medications upon arrival in San Ysidro, California.
